

Caring for your Implant Crown



Brushing

Brush at least twice a day for a minimum of 2 minutes. Waterpiks are helpful to flush “hard to reach” areas under your implant.

Flossing

Wrap the floss around each implant in a “C” shape and gently hug the side of the tooth. Move the floss up & down several times to loosen and remove food/bacteria. Use a new section of floss for each implant. For larger areas, you may use an interdental brush.

Make sure to come in twice per year for your routine dental cleaning and checkup appointments. These visits will keep your implant, teeth, and gums in good condition.

Some crowns may need to be adjusted after initial placement. If your bite feels abnormal or if you have any discomfort, please contact our office.
