The temporary crown is held in place with temporary glue. Avoid eating on the side of your mouth where the temporary crown is located. Avoid hard, chewy food and hot / icy drinks.

2. Gentle brushing and flossing:

Since the seal is not as tight as it would be on a permanent crown, please use only a manual toothbrush along the area. When flossing the area, tie a knot on the floss and gently push in and pull out from the side. no popping floss out.
